- ▶ Election of new Audit Committee for 2026.

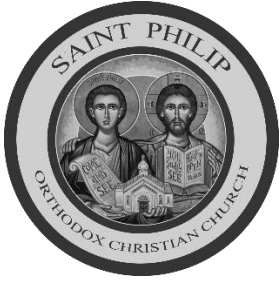
In addition, a cemetery update and Saint Justin Academy report will be presented.
